

ELECTIONS HELD AND BUDGET ADOPTED

At an Open Forum followed by a Voters Meeting on November 8, 2015 the members of our Ministry Council for 2016. Those elected for two year terms were: Dale Taylor, chairman; Kristopher Taylor, Treasurer; Ronald Wilhelm, Property Elder; Samuel DeLaurentis, Evangelism Elder; Tom Pindelski, Christian Education Elder. Continuing there service for 2016 are Brian Garcia, Adult Spiritual Growth Elder; Michael Salas, Secretary and Tom Pindelski, Vice-Chairman. We currently have no one holding the office of Stewardship Elder. Please keep all of these men in your prayers as they serve St. Andrew and our Lord.

A budget of \$124,510 was adopted. This is \$3,200 less than last year. Since offerings fell well below projections, we have a \$3,250 deficit if offerings remain the same. The Ministry Council is making plans to have a Stewardship drive in January to encourage our members to increase their offerings.

St. Andrew Church News

The focus of St. Andrew Church is exactly where it should be. We are focusing on the celebration of God's greatest gift to us, his Son and our Savior Jesus Christ. The Theme for our Advent and Christmas Worship this year is Ring out the Good News. We have been looking at people in the Bible who rang out the Good News of Jesus in our Wednesday and Sunday Services. Our service at 7:00 on Christmas Eve will feature a live Nativity as we focus on how we all can Ring Out the Good News of our Saviors Birth. At 11:00 pm on Christmas Eve we will continue a tradition that has been around for many years with our Candle Light Service. We will sing our favorite Christmas Hymns. In a darkened sanctuary lit by candles held by each worshipper, the congregation will join in singing *Silent Night*. Tom Pindelski will sing *O Holy Night*. We invite all of you to join us if possible as we worship our newborn King.

Boiler Update

The new church boiler is now installed and running well. The final cost of the project was around \$40,000. Our Ministry Council has established a boiler fund to help cover the cost of this unexpected expense. We are hoping and praying that some of our former members and friends of St. Andrew will help us with this project.
